Writing Samples/Observations:

- ① A surprisingly dark shade of violet. A wet line may even appear as dark-grey at first sight.
- ② I.m.h.o. suitable for staple use, especially for those who are just tired of the "safe" dark blues & blacks.
- ③ The nice features of this ink come into view at their best when used in a drier type of pen (more violet) or in a pen like this, with a (semi) flex nib (more shading).
